

Ebola Viruses


Transmission to wild animals such as monkeys and gorillas occur

Signs & Symptoms of Ebola










Extreme Fatigue

Vomiting




Diarrhea

The 2014 Ebola outbreak in Africa is the largest in history and is affecting multiple countries.






However there are two potential vaccine


